

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
**OF**  
**BOYLE COUNTY BAND ASSOCIATION, INC.**

These articles of incorporation are made and entered into on this 5 day of November 2007, for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky as follows:

**ARTICLE I**

The name of the corporation is **Boyle County Band Association, Inc.**, and by such name, it shall be known as a body corporate and its duration shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE II**

The purpose for which the corporation is formed shall be the promotion and encouragement of music education; to lend all possible support both morally and financially, to the BOYLE COUNTY SCHOOLS BAND PROGRAMS and its students and teachers.

**ARTICLE III**

The address of the registered and principal office of the corporation in the Commonwealth of Kentucky is 165 Old Bridge Road, Danville, Boyle County, Kentucky 40422-9783. The name of the registered agent of the corporation is William R. Summers.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

The initial board of directors consist of seven (7) members whose names and addresses are as follows:

#### **ARTICLE V**

The corporation may adopt a corporation seal, and it has the power to contract and be contracted with, to sue and be sued, and it may receive, accept, purchase or acquire in any other lawful manner real and personal property, and it may dispose of same by gift, deed, or in any other lawful manner, for the benefit of the corporation, or any other cause or causes of a charitable or educational nature. The corporation shall further have all powers provided by KRS 273.171 and other applicable law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried out (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

## **ARTICLE VI**

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

## **ARTICLE VII**

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to benefit music education in the Boyle County Schools, or for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

## **ARTICLE VIII**

The corporation formed hereby shall have no capital stock, and shall be composed of members rather than shareholders.

## **ARTICLE IX**

Members or directors of the corporation shall not be personally liable for any debt or obligation of the corporation solely by reason of being members or directors.


**ARTICLE X**
