



STUDENT DIRECTORY INFORMATION NOTIFICATION

We are required by law to release certain directory information to Armed Forces recruiters and institutions of higher education upon their request. However, you may direct us not to release such information for your child. If we receive no response within thirty (30) days, we will release all student directory information to legitimate sources as indicated (i.e., school-sponsored/-endorsed extracurricular programs, third parties limited to potential employers, institutions of higher learning, Armed Forces recruiters). Consistent with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), parents (or students 18 or older) may direct the District not to disclose directory information listed below.
